

INFORMATION ON THE PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA CUSTOMERS AND SUPPLIERS
in accordance with EU Regulation 2016/679 and Legislative Decree 196/03

With regard to the processing of personal data provided, we inform you that:

1. Data Controller

The Data Controller is the company Chimar Srl, with registered office in Cadoneghe (Padua) via E. Majorana No. 24 – 35010, tel. 049 8885211, e-mail amministrazione@chimar.com, registered email address chimar@cert.neispa.com (hereinafter referred to as “the Company”).

2. Type of data processed, Purpose and legal basis of Processing

The following personal data is collected and processed: personal data of a general nature (name surname, personal details, role within the company, contact data, email, mobile phone), referring to: companies/entities customers and suppliers and contact points-employees-collaborators-subcontractors of customers/suppliers, possibly communicated by them, for: a) pre-contractual purposes and execution of the contractual relationship, b) administrative-accounting-tax and legal obligations related to billing and management of the contractual relationship.

The legal basis of data processing is therefore: the fulfilment of contractual obligations for the purposes referred to in letter a); legal obligations, for the purposes referred to in letter b).

3. Communication of data to third parties – Recipients of data

The Company will be able to communicate the data processed for the above purposes to: i) internal corporate entities in charge of processing; ii) external entities belonging to the following categories: external consultants and their representatives/service companies (transport and shipping companies)/banks, insurance companies and credit institutions/entities and bodies of control.

4. Transfer of data to Third Countries

The processed data shall not be transferred by the Data Controller to Third Countries. However, in the event of any transfer of data to Third Countries, the transfer shall take place in accordance with the legislation in force on a case-by-case basis with regard to the transfer of data to Third Countries.

5. Methods of processing, period and criteria of data retention

The data will be processed in paper and digital format. The data will be processed by the Data Controller for the necessary period for the execution of the said purposes, and at the end of the same period for a further statutory period with regards to the preservation of contracts and administrative data and/or for defence in court (ten years) from the last use and/or interruption of the provision).

6. Provision of data

The provision of data is mandatory for the execution of the contractual relationship and the purposes of law. A failure to provide data shall make it impossible to pursue the said purposes.

7. The Rights of the individual, Revocation of Consent and Complaint to the Control Authority

The individual has the right at any time to request access to his personal data, its rectification, deletion, limitation, to oppose the processing and to exercise the right to data portability whenever possible.

In any case, the individual has the right to revoke at any time the consent given to the processing of data, without prejudice to the lawfulness of the processing based on the consent given prior to the revocation.

In the case of a presumed violation, the individual, having recourse to the conditions, also has the right to make a complaint to a Data Control Authority in the EU member state where he habitually resides or in the EU state where he works or where the alleged violation has taken place.

8. Profiling and automated decision-making processes

Processing shall not be carried out by automated decision-making processes (e.g. profiling).

9. Contacts and requests
