

**INFORMATION ON DATA PROCESSING “CONTACTS” SECTION OF THE WEBSITE  
as stated in EU Regulation 2016/679 and Legislative Decree 196/03**

With regard to the processing of the personal data provided, we inform you that:

**1. Data Controller**

The Data Controller is the company Chimar Srl, with registered office in Cadoneghe (Padua) via E. Majorana No. 24 – 35010, tel. 049 8885211, e-mail [amministrazione@chimar.com](mailto:amministrazione@chimar.com), registered email address [chimar@cert.neispa.com](mailto:chimar@cert.neispa.com) (hereinafter referred to as “the Company”).

**2. Type of data processed, Purpose and legal basis of Processing**

The data collected in the format is general personal data necessary to fulfil your request and respond to it. Legal basis of data processing: fulfilment of contractual obligations.

**3. Communication of data to third parties – Recipients of data**

The Company may communicate the data processed for the purposes set out above to the internal and external parties that work together to fulfil your request, as well as to the external company that manages the website.

**4. Transfer of data to Third Countries**

The data processed may be transferred by the Data Controller to Third Countries for the purposes indicated above. However, in the event of any transfer of data to Third Countries, the transfer shall take place in accordance with the legislation in force on a case-by-case basis with regard to the transfer of data to Third Countries pursuant to Article 44 and subsequent GDPR 2016/679.

**5. Methods of processing, period and criteria of data retention**

The data shall be processed in digital format and with electronic tools for the period necessary for the execution of the said purposes, and in any case for a period not exceeding two years from sending the request.

**6. Profiling and automated decision-making processes**

Processing shall not be carried out by automated decision-making processes (e.g. profiling).

**7. Provision of data**

The provision of data marked as mandatory is essential for the execution of the contractual relationship and the purposes of the law. A failure to provide data shall make it impossible to pursue the said purposes.

**8. The Rights of the individual, Revocation of Consent and Complaint to the Control Authority**

The individual has the right at any time to request access to his personal data, its rectification, deletion, limitation, to oppose the processing, to revoke the consent given and to exercise the right to data portability, in cases where this is applicable, by contacting the Data Controller as indicated below.

In case of presumed violation, the individual, where the prerequisites have been met, also has the right to make a complaint to a Data Control Authority in the EU member state where he habitually resides or in the EU state where he works or where the alleged violation has taken place.
