

**INFORMATION ON THE PROCESSING OF PERSONAL VIDEO SURVEILLANCE DATA**  
**Article 13 EU Regulation 2016/679**

With regard to the processing of personal data provided, we inform you that:

**1. Data Controller**

The Data Controller is the company Chimar Srl, with registered office in Cadoneghe (Province of Padua) Via E. Majorana No. 24 - 35010, tel. 049 8885211, e-mail [amministrazione@chimar.com](mailto:amministrazione@chimar.com), pec [chimar@cert.neispa.com](mailto:chimar@cert.neispa.com) (hereinafter referred to as "the Company").

**2. Type of data processed, Purpose and legal basis of the Processing**

The following personal data is collected and processed: personal data of a common nature (images recorded by video surveillance systems - CCTV), concerning employees, customers, third parties, for: a) organisational and production needs; b) workplace safety; c) protection of company assets.

The legal basis of the processing is therefore the legitimate interest of the Controller.

**3. Communication of data to third parties - Recipients of the data**

The Company may communicate the data processed for the purposes referred to above to: i) entities and system administrators in charge of processing the data collected by video surveillance systems; ii) the Company that manages the video surveillance or maintenance systems; iii) Law Enforcement agencies; iv) consultants in the event of disputes.

**4. Transfer of data to Third Countries**

The data processed shall not be transferred by the Controller to Third Countries. However, in case of transfer to Third Countries, this will be done in compliance with the legislation on a case-by-case basis for the transfer of data to third countries pursuant to Article 44 and following of General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) 2016/679.

**5. Processing methods, period and data retention criteria**

The data shall be processed in digital format. The images shall be kept for 5 days, unless they are set aside for the protection of rights or for other legal reasons (in which case they are kept for the time necessary to fulfill the purpose for which they were saved and, at the end of the period, for the additional statutory legal period of defence in court (10 years from the last use and/or interruption of the statute of limitations).

**6. Provision of data**

The provision of data shall be mandatory and automatic in consideration of the legitimate interest of the Controller

**7. Rights of the interested party, Revocation of Consent and Complaint to the Supervisory Authority**

The interested party shall have the right at any time to request access to his/her personal data, its rectification, deletion, limitation, to oppose its processing and to exercise the right to data portability.

In any case, the interested party shall have the right to revoke at any time the consent given to the processing of data, without prejudice to the lawfulness of the processing based on the consent given prior to the revocation. In the event of alleged violation, the interested party, having recourse to the conditions, shall have the right to lodge a complaint with a Data Supervisory Authority in the EU member state where he/she resides habitually or in the EU State where he/she works or where the violation occurred.

**8. Profiling and automated decision-making processes**

Processing shall not be carried out by automated decision-making processes (e.g. profiling).

**9. Contacts and requests**
