

## **PRIVACY POLICY OF THE WEBSITE**

This page describes how to manage the website in relation to the processing of personal data of users who consult it. Following consultation of this website, data relating to identified or identifiable persons may be processed. This is information that is given to those who interact with the web services of the Data Controller, available electronically from the address:

Please note that the information is provided only for the above website and not for other websites that may be consulted by the user through links.

### **1. Data Controller**

The Data Controller is the company Chimar Srl, with registered office in Cadoneghe (Padua) via E. Majorana No. 24 – 35010, tel. 049 8885211, e-mail [amministrazione@chimar.com](mailto:amministrazione@chimar.com), registered email address [chimar@cert.neispa.com](mailto:chimar@cert.neispa.com) (hereinafter referred to as “the Company”).

The Company has not decided to appoint a DPO (Data Protection Officer) as it is deemed unnecessary under EU Regulation 2016/679 (link: [https://eur-lex.europa.eu/legal-content/IT/TXT/?uri=uriserv:OJ.L\\_.2016.119.01.0001.01.ITA](https://eur-lex.europa.eu/legal-content/IT/TXT/?uri=uriserv:OJ.L_.2016.119.01.0001.01.ITA)). However, the company has identified an internal privacy contact point for any privacy requests as indicated below.

### **2. Type of data processed, Purpose and legal basis of Processing**

#### **- Navigation data**

The computer systems and software procedures used to operate this website acquire, during their normal operation, some personal data whose transmission is implicit in the use of Internet communication protocols. This is information that is not collected to be associated with identified individuals, but which by its very nature could, through processing and association with data held by third parties, allow users to be identified. This category of data includes IP addresses or domain names of the computers used by users who connect to the website, the addresses in the Uniform Resource Identifier (URI) notation of the requested resources, the time of the request, the method used to submit the request to the server, the size of the file obtained in response, the numerical code indicating the status of the response given by the server (success, error, etc.), and other parameters relating to the operating system and the user's computer environment.

This data is used for the sole purpose of checking the correct functioning of the website. The data may be used to establish responsibility in the case of hypothetical computer crimes against the website.

The legal basis of the processing is therefore a legitimate interest of the controller in carrying out and improving the services of the website provided.

#### **- Data provided voluntarily by the user**

The optional, explicit and voluntary sending of e-mails to the addresses indicated on this website or the compilation of specific data entry formats to receive services/information or make requests shall require the subsequent acquisition of the sender's address, necessary to respond to requests, as well as any other personal data entered.

The personal data provided by users who submit requests (contact requests, sending CV etc ...) are processed for the sole purpose of performing the service or provision requested, unless otherwise provided in any further specific information on the processing of data on specific login or registration pages.

Specific summary information and possible requests for consent, if necessary, will be progressively reported or displayed on the pages of the website prepared for particular services upon request.

The legal basis of processing is therefore the fulfilment of contractual obligations (requests) of the requesting user/consent.

#### **- Cookies**

The website uses technical cookies.

No cookies are used for the transmission of personal information.

The legal basis of the processing is therefore the legitimate interest of the controller in the case of technical cookies.

### **3. Communication of data to third parties and Transfer of data to Third Countries.**

No data deriving from the web service shall be distributed.

The personal data provided by the user (such as: name, surname, email, telephone, information contained) are managed by the internal entities of the company to respond to requests.

The navigation data and personal data provided by the user and the other types of data processed are not transferred to Third Countries.

**4. Methods of processing, period and data retention criteria, Automated processes**

Personal data are processed using computer tools.

The personal data provided by the user is kept for the period necessary for the execution of the purposes indicated.

The navigation data is kept for the period necessary for the execution of the purposes indicated.

No automated decision-making process, including profiling, is carried out through the website.

Specific security measures are observed to prevent data loss, illicit or incorrect use and unauthorised access.

**5. Provision of data**

Apart from what is specified for navigation data, the user is free to provide the personal data contained on the application forms or indicated in contacts with the Controller. Failure to provide such data may make it impossible to obtain the object of the request.

The undersigned company, the owner of the website and the Data Controller, reserves the right to cancel the registration and to discontinue the provision of the services if the data provided to access certain services turns out to be untrue.

**6. Rights of the individual, the Method of making a complaint and Revocation of Consent**

The entities to whom the personal data refer have the right at any time to request access to their personal data, its rectification, deletion, limitation, to oppose the processing and to exercise the right to data portability. In any case, the individual has the right to revoke at any time the consent given to the processing of data, without prejudice to the lawfulness of the processing based on the consent given prior to the revocation.
